

HSE POLICY STATEMENT

Health, Safety and Environment (HSE) issues are of paramount importance to the management and operations of PSG. The company is committed to the health and safety of its personnel and the public, as well as the protection of the environment.

Objectives

 - Identifying and indicating the potential dangers with visual signs
 - Training and involving the employees in the prevention of accidents and pollution
 - Sensitizing the employees on their social and environmental responsibilities
- ✓ Investigate all accidents and incidents and put in measures to prevent recurrence.

The Employees engage themselves to adhere to the safety and environmental protection principles at the workplace by:

- ✓ Respecting the safety and environmental regulations of the company;
- ✓ Respecting the procedures in place to protect the health and safety of the employees and the environment;
- ✓ Respecting the safety and environmental instructions and signs of the company;
- ✓ Reporting incidents and accidents at the workplace;
- ✓ Collaborating on preventing incidents and accidents at the workplace.
