



The Agripalma concession has been developed on the demand of the Government of Sao Tome. The objectives being: supply the local market (all vegetable oils are imported) and create and export activity in order to have access to foreign currency.

The plantation has been developed on a former EEC palm oil project and cacao plantations. It forms a buffer against illegal logging in and poaching in the Obo National Park. 2 210 ha have been replanted with oil palm.
