



The Brabanta oil palm plantation was created by Unilever in 1911. It was exploited by Unilever up to 1990 and had subsequently been abandoned. The old Unilever labourers begged Socfin to modernise the plantation. Rehabilitation was started and today 6 169 ha have been replanted. Adequate medical and social infrastructures have been erected and a new mill was installed on the site of the old Unilever mill.

Brabanta plays a strategic role in the supply of vegetable oil on the local market.
