



The Liberian Agricultural Company was created by the Government in 1959 and was later purchased by Uniroyal. Because of political unrest Uniroyal proceeded into a management buyout but LAC was completely destroyed during the civil wars at the end of the 20<sup>th</sup> century.

At the request of the International Finance Corporation and the French Development Bank Socfin undertook in 1998 the rehabilitation of the rubber plantation and its infrastructure (schools, hospital, mill, housing, roads...)

Today still 7 000 ha of the partly destroyed rubber plantations must be rehabilitated.
